**** TRANSFER STATION PERMITS EXPIRE SEPTEMBER 30 ****

Permits for admission to the Town’s Transfer Station may be purchased through the mail to the Treasurer/Collector’s Office, purchased in person at the Treasurer/Collector’s Office in Town Hall, and may be renewed online. Please see the instructions enclosed with this information. Permits may not be purchased at the Transfer Station. Only Weston residents may use the Town’s Transfer Station to dispose of trash and recyclables.

The annual fee is \$240.00 with the permit expiring on September 30, 2019. You may purchase a permit for an additional vehicle(s) for \$39.00 per year. Residents 65 years of age or older may purchase a permit for \$148.00. Residents may also purchase a recycle only sticker for \$35.00 which will allow recycling of yard waste and all other items recycled at the Transfer Station. Please see the Recycling insert included in this mailing for a complete list of Recyclables. These fees support approximately 75 percent of the operational costs associated with solid waste disposal and recycling. Please call 781-786-5070 with any questions about purchasing a permit.

Low-income residents meeting certain financial need guidelines are eligible for a waiver of the fee. Please call the Selectmen’s Office at 781-786-5020 for more information on this program.

Permits are not valid unless permanently affixed to the inside lower left (driver’s) side of the windshield of the vehicle. Permits must be clearly visible from the driver’s side of the vehicle. Please remove all old permits. Permits can be removed with the help of a razor blade. The Transfer Station attendants will be happy to assist you with this.

You are encouraged to contact the Department of Public Works at 781-786-5100 with any questions regarding residential solid waste disposal and recycling, or go to the Public Works web page at www.weston.org/DPW and review the **Transfer Station Info** section. Please be advised we are unable to accept any waste associated with construction and demolition, including home remodeling.
