## **Demolition Application Process**

1. Complete Demolition Permit Application Form and submit with \$100.00 or \$250.00 fee. Checks made payable to the *Town of Weston*.
2. Provide asbestos inspection report. If applicable, provide asbestos abatement report.
3. Provide lead inspection report including all planned interior and exterior areas of disturbance for the project. If applicable, provide lead abatement report and measures to ensure compliance with 454 CMR 22.00.
4. Provide a lead abatement plan for total or partial removal of lead contaminated surfaces.
5. Remove all pesticides, herbicides, cleaning materials, paints, and hazardous materials from the dwelling.
6. Remove thermostats containing mercury and hold them for collection by the Board of Health during the final inspection.
7. Contact Board of Health to schedule an inspection of the dwelling after all of the inspections are complete and all hazardous materials have been removed.
